

REPLACING A CITADEL MOTOR

Step 1: Remove the tek screws from the hood and remove the front of the housing box.

Step 2: Remove the roller tube with fabric from the housing box.

Step 3: Place fabric and tube somewhere flat and clean, and unroll the fabric until the roller is exposed.

Step 4: Remove the screws around the motor side of the tube.

Step 5: Slide the motor out of the tube. The motor crown and drive should be attached to one another and come out in one piece.

Step 6 :Slide new motor (motor, crown, and drive) back in to the tube, the same way you took the other one out.

Step 7: Replace the screws.

Step 8: Roll the fabric back up on the tube making sure it is tight and even on the tube.

Step 9: RE-install tube and fabric with new motor in the box/housing. Replace the front of the housing box and the tek screws.

Step 10: After everything is put back together, you can then set the limits for the new motor following the instructions on the website.
