

Changing the Cord Loop on the Omni-Rise

- Completely lower the shade. Slide the clutch assembly out of the headrail as far as the spears will allow.
- Remove the clutch cover. Gently lift up the latch on the top of the clutch. Then rock the cover off the clutch, pivoting it at the bottom.
- Remove the loop. Bend the cord out of the channel, into the space between two pulley "teeth." Use the cord as a handle to pull the pulley all the way around to the other channel.

- 4. Insert the new loop. Select an appropriate cord length for the shade. When finished, both sides of the loop must emerge in the front of the clutch.
- 5. Once the cord engages a pulley tooth at the upper channel opening, use the cord to rotate the pulley all the way around to the lower channel.
- 6. Replace the clutch cover. Place the bottom tab of the clutch cover at the bottom of the clutch. Swing the top end up and snap into place.
