REPLACING A CITADEL MOTOR (please reference installation instructions for any clarification)

Step 1: Remove tracks.

Step 2: Remove the Tek screws from the hood and remove the front of the housing box.

Step 3: Remove the roller tube with fabric from the housing box.

Step 4: Place fabric and tube somewhere flat and clean and unroll the fabric until the roller is exposed.

Step 5: Remove the screws around the motor side of the tube.

Step 6: Slide the motor out of the tube. The motor crown and drive should be attached to one another and come out in one piece.

Step 7: Slide the new motor (motor, crown, and drive) back into the tube, the same way you took the other one out. If the new motor does not have a crown and drive on it, take the crown and drive off the old motor and install it on the new one.

Step 8: Replace the screws.

Step 9: Roll the fabric back up on the tube making sure it is tight and even on the tube.

Step 10: RE-install tube and fabric with new motor in the box/housing. Replace the front of the housing box and the Tek screws.

Step 11: reinstall tracks.

Step 12: After everything is put back together, you can then set the limits for the new motor following the instructions on the website.
